
We are aware that some users have faced issues with Googlemaps where the 'Continue button' becomes unresponsive. This is due to a recent update on Googlemaps and we are in communication with them about it.



## A workaround is to uninstall the latest Google Maps update and disable auto-updates.

To do this please follow the below steps, as shown in the video:

Step 1: Turning off the auto updates

- 1. Open Google Play Store
- 2. Type in Google Maps and tap on it to open it
- 3. Tap the three dots on the top right-hand corner
- 4. Select 'Turn off auto-updates'

## Step 2: Uninstalling Google maps updates

- 1. On your Android phone, open Settings.
- 2. Tap Apps and notifications.
- 3. Tap Show all apps.
- 4. Tap Google Maps/Maps.
- 5. Tap the three dots in the top right-hand corner
- 6. Tap 'Uninstall Updates'.

Step 3: \*\*Very important\*\*

Once you have followed the steps and arrived at your first stop, Google may prompt you to update to the latest version as shown above. **Do not accept this update**.

To avoid this please do the following:

- 1. Select 'Dismiss'. In case the dismiss button is not responsive, please select the 'Back button' to ignore the update request.
- 2. Continue using the Googlemaps as normal
